MICRO-ENTERPRISE

Eagle Condor Humanitarian (ECH) believes the best way create change for good is to teach others how to help themselves. ECH provides rigorous entrepreneurial training courses where qualifying participants are taught business strategies, accounting and marketing skills. Upon completion of the course, and based on the approval of their business plan, graduates are eligible to receive small loans to start their new business. Our capable staff in Peru then continues to support loan recipients through weekly consultations for a least one year. On average, three new employment positions are created by each new business started. Loan funds are revolving and self-sustaining thanks to initial donations from people like you. Currently ECH has programs for entrepreneurs in Chiclayo, Trujillo, Piura and Cajamarca Peru. Programs are underway for Bolivia, Ecuador and Colombia.



HUMANITARIAN EXPEDITIONS



EVERY YEAR ENERGETIC VOLUNTEERS DONATE THEIR TIME and money to travel to Peru, Ecuador or Colombia with Eagle Condor Humanitarian. Traditional expeditions have volunteers working alongside native people to provide clean drinking water, hygiene workshops, food programs, greenhouses, children's shelters, or any number of community improvement projects to achieve long term change for better living and self-reliance. Youth, Dental, Medical and Customized expeditions are designed around specific skills and project goals and can be scheduled anytime throughout the year. Expeditions are generally 10 days long and include side excursions to culturally rich locations of interest such as Machu Picchu and the Galapagos Islands. SPONSORSHIPS

CHILDREN UNDER THE CARE OF EAGLE-CONDOR HUMANITARIAN have either been abandoned, or are at-risk of being so, due to extreme poverty with little opportunity to pursue formal education. ECH works with children to provide the basics of food, shelter and hygiene so they can more easily gain access to education and skill development. We try to provide interns in all our locations to work one-on-one with children to foster personal identity, self esteem, habits of cleanliness, order, discipline and work. 100% of child sponsorship monies go to support the children. Our aim is to have our children feel loved and eventually enter into the job market having the tools and experiences to communicate and decide their own development.
